Don't delay...Become an American Red Cross CPR/AED and First Aid Instructor today! Build your own training team!

By becoming a Red Cross Instructor you can build your own training team and teach courses to your employees at your business or members of your organization whenever and wherever you want. This class will train candidates as instructors in Adult CPR/Automated External Defibrillator, Child CPR/Automated External Defibrillator, Infant CPR and First Aid. **Crossover examination for Professional Rescue CPR/AED, Bloodborne Pathogens and other Red Cross Health and Safety classes can be scheduled upon completion of the basic instructor class. There is additional classroom time and fees for "crossover" materials and certifications. In some programs, such as Professional Rescue CPR/AED, you must first obtain the student level certification.**

Pre-registration is required. Payment is due at time of registration. Registrations can be mailed, delivered in person, faxed or by phone with a credit card. Space is limited. No refunds will be given for no-shows or without two business days advance notice. No refunds will be given to those who fail the course. All classes will be held at the Cornhusker Chapter of the American Red Cross in Lincoln, Nebraska. There are vending machines available in our building. Breaks will be given. Students must attend all classes and stay the entire time or they will forfeit their opportunity to certify as an instructor.

Instructor candidates who wish to teach CPR/AED and First Aid classes in their workplace will need to complete an Authorized Provider Agreement. Please note there is a financial responsibility in being a Red Cross Authorized Provider and/or teaching Red Cross courses. Some of these items include the purchase of books (which are required), CPR manikin purchase or rental, DVD purchase or rental, administrative/certification fee, cost of gloves, face shields, etc. An Authorized Provider Agreement must be signed by every business that teaches Red Cross Health and Safety Classes. If a business fails to sign an Authorized Provider Agreement with the Red Cross and instructors teach classes, students will not receive certificates and will not be recognized as completing a Red Cross course. American Red Cross Instructor classes offer a variety of lecture, DVD and hands on instruction to meet individuals learning styles. Volunteer teaching opportunities are available through the Lancaster County Chapter to help you gain teaching experience.

The American Red Cross CPR/AED and First Aid Program is a training program to prepare individuals to respond to injuries and sudden illnesses that may arise in the workplace. This program offers a choice of first aid and CPR courses and injury-control modules to meet the training needs of employers and their employees. American Red Cross CPR/AED and First Aid classes meet OSHA guidelines and the Cardiovascular Care 2005 Guidelines.

All books and supplies will be provided for the instructor's class. Students should bring a pen/pencil and paper for notes. Dress comfortable as you will be working on the floor often. Students must attend all sessions. If you fail to attend all sessions you may have to wait for the next instructor class to make-up missed time. You will not obtain your instructor certificate until you have met all requirements.
